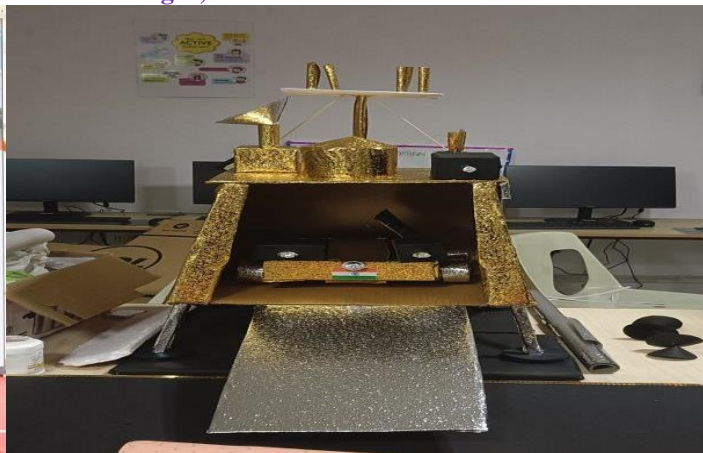

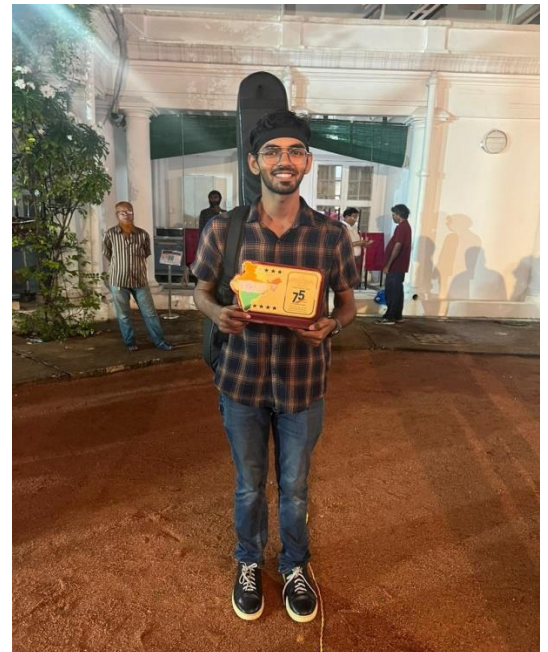

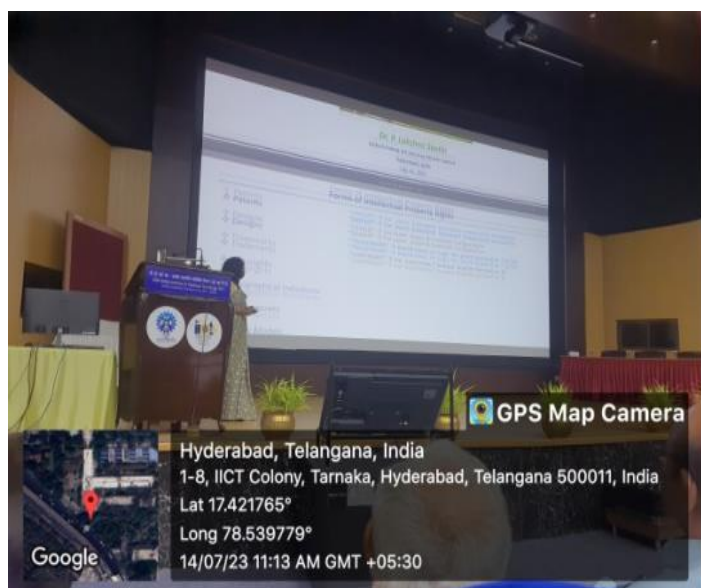


## ACADEMIC FOCUS

The CSIR- IICT conducts research in basic and applied chemistry, biochemistry, bioinformatics, and chemical engineering and provides science and technology inputs to the industrial and economic development of the country. IICT has filed greatest number of CSIR patents. During the training period faculty and students are trained about intellectual properties which include copyright, patent, license, trade mark and explained about different kinds of intellectual property rights, patentable and non-patentable items, types of patents, scope of patent and patentability criteria, novelty and inventiveness of technology, inventive step or non-obviousness and stages from filing to grant of patents.

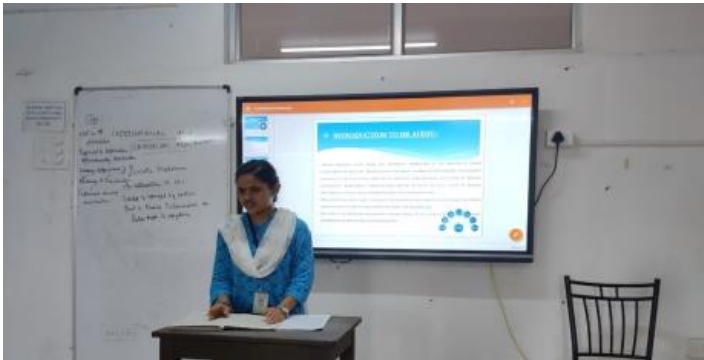

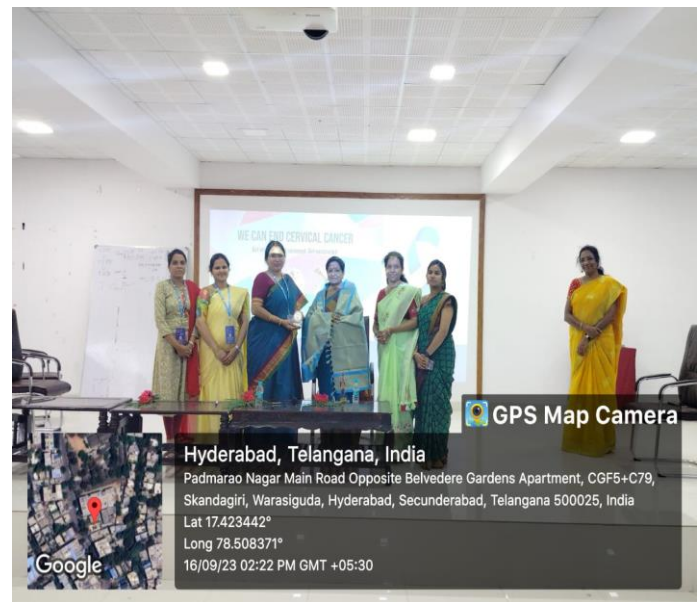
