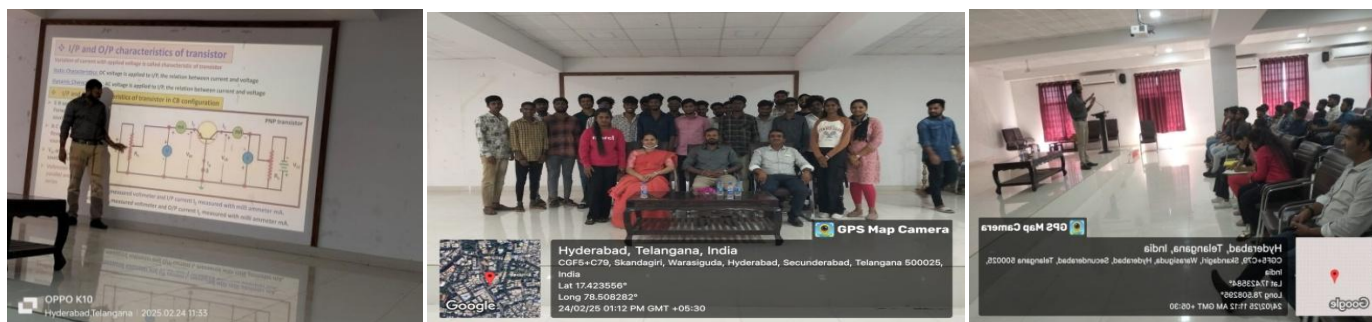
Department of computer Science

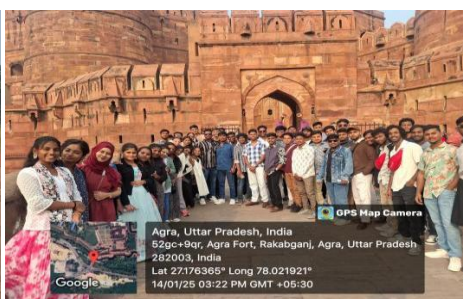
