About the College

Established in 1970, **Sardar Patel College**, Sponsored and Managed Jointly by the **Osmania Graduates' Association** and **Exhibition Society**, serves the educational needs of economically and academically underprivileged students in Telangana. The college is known for excellence in academics, co-curricular and extracurricular activities.

We offer a wide range of Undergraduate programs—**BA, BBA, B.Com. and B.Sc.**, Postgraduate programs—**M.Com, M.Sc. (Organic Chemistry), and MBA**. The institution fosters a holistic learning environment with modern teaching methods and interactive learning spaces.

Accreditation & Collaboration

The college is **re-accredited by NAAC with a B+ grade and 2.67 CGPA in 2022**. In line with **NEP 2020** and **UGC** guidelines, the college is part of a **Cluster College initiative** to promote **multidisciplinary education and research**.

Infrastructure & Facilities

The college campus spans **3.8 acres**, consisting of an **Old Block** with spacious classrooms and a **New Block** with three floors housing administrative offices, well-ventilated classrooms, laboratories, and a **300-seater air-conditioned multipurpose auditorium**. Additionally, **Shri Shankerji Auditorium** accommodates **1,000 persons** and is used for Academic and cultural events.

There are 55 classrooms, science labs, four well-equipped computer labs with over 245 systems, and ICT-enabled classrooms. High-end copiers and a server room support academic and administrative work. Projectors are available for effective teaching and student presentations.



Library

In 2006, the college libraries were fully automated with the New GenLib Integrated Library Management System (ILMS), Version Helium 3.2 (Subscription ID: NGL176).

Our **automated library** (IMLS New GenLib) was computerized in 2006 and upgraded in 2009. It holds **64,000 books, 25,000 titles, 12 journals, and 60 e-book titles** and subscription to **INFLIBNET (N-LIST)**.

The Institution has two libraries:

- **UG Library:** Ground floor, 3700 sq. ft.
- **PG Library:** First floor, 1143 sq. ft.

Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

Osmania University has adopted the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) to enhance the flexibility, interdisciplinary learning, and overall quality of education. This system allows students to choose courses across disciplines, fostering a more personalized and comprehensive academic experience.

UG Program Structure

For Undergraduate (UG) programs, the CBCS framework includes:

- **Total Credits:** Typically ranges from **120 to 132 credits** over the duration of the program.

Course Types:

- **Compulsory Core Courses:** Fundamental subjects central to the discipline.
- **Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC):** Courses aimed at improving skills and competencies.
- **Discipline Specific Electives (DSE):** Advanced courses within the chosen discipline.
- **Generic Electives (GE):** Courses from other disciplines to broaden knowledge.
- **Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC):** Courses designed to develop specific skills.

PG Program Structure

for Postgraduate (PG) programs, the CBCS framework includes:

- **Interdisciplinary Courses:** Students have the option to select two interdisciplinary courses, one each in the third and fourth semesters, offered by other departments or faculties.
- **Project Work:** A project is undertaken during the fourth semester as part of the regular course work.
- **Continuous Evaluation:** Evaluation is based on internal assessments, assignments, seminars, and project work.
- **Credit System:** Each course, seminar, and project work is assigned a specific number of credits, and the performance is expressed as Grade Point Average (GPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA).

Placement Cell

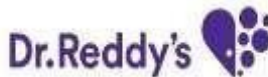

Rules and Regulations

Admissions Procedure

Sardar Patel College offers admissions to **Undergraduate (UG)** and **Postgraduate (PG)** programs through a structured, merit-based process aligned with the guidelines of the **Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TSCHE)**. The college ensures transparency, equal opportunity and adherence to academic standards.

Undergraduate (UG) Admissions

Admissions to UG programs (B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., etc.) are facilitated through the **Degree Online Services, Telangana (DOST)** portal. (**DOST ID - 11189**)

- **Registration:**

Candidates must register online at dost.cgg.gov.in by submitting personal, academic and course preference details.

- **Seat Allotment:**

Seats are allotted based on the candidate's merit (marks in qualifying examination), category, and course preferences.

- **Required Documents:**

- Original Transfer Certificate (TC)
- SSC & Intermediate marks memos
- Aadhar Card
- Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- 4 - Recent passport-sized photographs

- **Admission Confirmation:**

After allotment, candidates must report to the college for document verification and fee payment to confirm admission.

Postgraduate (PG) Admissions

1. MBA Program

Admission to MBA is through the **Telangana State Integrated Common Entrance Test (TSICET)**.

- **Eligibility:** A bachelor's degree with at least 45% aggregate marks (40% for reserved categories).
- **Admission Process:**
 - Qualify TSICET with a valid rank.
 - Participate in TSICET counseling.
 - Upon allotment, visit the college with original documents for verification and admission formalities.
 - Category B students (management quota) must purchase and submit a college admission form with required documents.

2. M.Sc. / M.Com. Programs

Admissions are based on **merit** or entrance exams like **CPGET (Common PG Entrance Test)** conducted by Osmania University.

- **Eligibility:**
 - A bachelor's degree in the relevant subject.
 - For M.Sc. Chemistry, candidates must have completed a minimum number of Chemistry papers in UG.
 - Final-year UG students may apply provisionally.
- **Admission Process:**
 - Apply through CPGET (if applicable).
 - Submit college application form along with required documents.
 - Attend counseling and complete admission process.



Details of Scholarships

The Telangana State Government provides financial support to eligible students pursuing undergraduate and postgraduate courses through various scholarship schemes:

E- PASS Scholarships

Available for **SC/ST/BC/EBC/Minority** students.

- Covers **tuition fee reimbursement** and **maintenance allowance**.
- Applicable for students whose **family income** is below:
 - ₹2 lakh per year (SC/ST)
 - ₹1.5 lakh in rural / ₹2 lakh in urban areas (BC/EBC/Minority)

Economically Poor People (EPP) Scholarship

- For students with a family income **below ₹12,000/year**.
- Offers a **monthly stipend**, but tuition fees must be paid by the student.
